



Trivia Night 2011 FAQ's

I know very little about Hollywood trivia. Is this for me?

Individuals are never asked to give answers alone. Answers are discussed at your table before the answer is written down. You might be surprised what knowledge you have hidden inside.

How many people can we have on our team?

With a minimum of four and a maximum of eight, you can have 4,5,6,7 or 8 people on your team.

What will happen at Trivia Night?

You'll have a fun, casual evening with teams of people from all over the community in the Duncan Aviation Flight Department hangar. Doors open/Registration begins at 5:30 including drinks and social time. This will be followed by the Silent Auction/Buffer Dinner beginning at 6:30. The competition will begin at 7:30. Trivia Night 2011 is designed for adults ages 21 and over. The cost of the buffet dinner and unlimited drinks is included in your registration fee.

Are there other activities beside the Trivia Competition?

Yes. There will also be a silent auction along with the Trivia Night competition. Auction items and bid sheets will be displayed on tables in the hangar. When you arrive, you will pick up your bid # at the registration table. The Silent Auction will complete at the conclusion of the Trivia Night intermission. Items will be ready to take home following the conclusion of the Trivia Night competition.

During intermission we will enjoy a game of Heads and Tails where you can purchase a bracelet for \$10 and the winner will split the pot with the Boys and Girls Club.

We will also have a wine bottle raffle, where you can purchase a raffle ticket for a \$30 donation with the chance of winning a wine basket at the end of the competition. For every ticket purchased, you will receive a bottle of wine to enjoy at your table during the evening.

Are there other competitions?

Absolutely!! There will be prizes to the teams judged the best in the following categories:

- Award for Visual Effect
- Award for Costume Design
- Award for Best Supporting Table
- Razzie Award

What should I wear?

Teams are encouraged to dress based on the theme of their team name. For those that are shy about a taking on a Hollywood look, jeans are appropriate. In Hollywood, we know details are everything, so be sure to dress your table to get that "Finished Look" your team will need to compete for prizes in our other events.

Can you tell me exactly how the Trivia Competition works?

I will gladly walk you through a round... Teams are at tables with answer sheets. The emcee will read the question, which will also be displayed on a big screen. Teams will have a short time to write down their answer. At this point you would hear a lot of whispering throughout the room and often times a lot of laughter. We will have runners in the room to pick up your answer and deliver it to the scoring table. After all the score sheets have been collected, the emcee will then provide everyone with the correct answer. There will be no waiting to see if you answered correctly!! After we have completed all the questions, the winning team will be revealed.

What if our team needs help with a question?

This is your lucky day!! Trivia Night 2011 is honored to welcome two Hollywood experts, Ron Hull and Leta Powell Drake. When registering, each team will have the option to purchase 'Ask the Expert' cards for \$20 each. Cards will also be sold during the game. When you get a stumper of a question, you will hold up your card to alert the Emcees. They will then consult the experts for their 'hopefully correct' answer which now becomes your answer.

How will team answers be scored?

Every correct answer yields one point. The team with the highest score wins. Tie-breaking questions will be offered in the event of a tie.

What do we receive if our team wins?

The winning team will be awarded the Trivia Night traveling trophy, which you'll want to display proudly for the year you hold the crown. There is no second prize for Trivia Night; the winning team will reign victorious.

What are the trivia categories?

Trivia Night 2011 will have a Hollywood theme and all questions will revolve around this theme.
